

SMALL ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

Occasionally the Toaster, Kettle or Microwave will stop working. It might be the supply of electricity to the wall socket. Try another electrical device in this wall socket and if it also does not work check the main fuse on the fuse board. If it does work then it may be that the small 13 amp fuse has blown in the plug to the appliance.

Change the fuse in the plug with another one. Make sure it is a 13 amp fuse which is a small brown tube. If this does not rescue the small appliance then give me a ring on.

In general Kettles and Toasters are about £30 and Microwaves are about £60.

If getting a microwave make sure it is small enough to fit into the aperture designed for it in the kitchen.
